



# Mob attacks group of youth, police over minor clash



Ahmedabad : A minor clash between groups of youth from two different communities in Veraval town snowballed into rioting on Friday night leaving five people severely injured including a police constable.

By Saturday early morning cops rounded up eight people from Mahatmapara area after they conducted a combing operation following the clash that started over a petty bickering between Vicky Mamaniya and Shaikh Fakir and soon escalated into a fist fight. When Mamaniya's friend Uday Koli intervened, Fakir mercilessly beat him two before being away. Mamaniya and Koli were taken to Civil Hospital for treatment where Fakir reached with a mob. Fakir stabbed Mamaniya and also his two other friends named Raju Chudasama and Vijay Almasi.

When cops arrived at the police station, the mob pelting stones at them damaging

# Mass marriage of orphan women in Rajkot faces Covid-19 strictures



Ahmedabad : The organisers of a mass marriage event of 12 orphan women along with the manager of a marriage hall were arrested by Rajkot city police on Sunday on charges of violating Covid-19 guidelines. Aji dam police officials said they received a tip off about mass wedding where Covid rules were being flagrantly violated.

"We have arrested the organisers Roshan Kumar alias Suraj Ramji Pandya (32), his wife Jagruti Pandya and manager of the marriage hall Mahesh Mayani (53) for inviting guests more than the maximum permissible limit of 50 as approved by the government for social gathering under the Covid-19 guidelines. There were over 250 guests in attendance at the event," police said. The marriage was organised at Shingar hall located near Ranuja temple on Kothariya Road in the city. The mass marriage was organised by Shree Ram Dhun Santvani Mandla managed by Roshan Kumar and Jagruti Pandya.

# Home Minister Amit Shah launches free vaccination drive in Gujarat



Ahmedabad: Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Monday kick-started the free mega-vaccination drive for those aged above 18 in Gujarat. He is on a two-day visit to the state. Urging people to get vaccinated, he said the Centre had decided to step up the pace of inoculation in July and August.

"Citizens will be vaccinated for free," Shah spoke during his visit to a vaccination centre at Pandit Deendayal Hall in Bodakdev in Ahmedabad. He was accompanied by mayor Kirit Parmar and senior officials of Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation. "Those who have already taken the first dose of the vaccine should get the second dose after the

stipulated gap and secure complete protection from the infection. Efforts are being made to increase the pace of vaccination in July-August. The mega-vaccination drive will play a major role in dealing with a likely third wave of the pandemic," Shah added.

With the launch of the drive, those in the age group of 18-44 can now avail of on-the-spot registration for vaccination. They will no longer need to get online registration done in advance.

Shah also inaugurated the newly built flyover over Valsindhi Devi circle on SG Highway in Ahmedabad. The flyover connects Ahmedabad with Gandhinagar and is aimed at easing traffic congestion on SG Highway.

Later, Amit Shah inaugurated the railway overbridge on Pansar-Chhatral road at a cost of Rs 34.92 crore and the APMC in Kalol, built at a cost of Rs 2 crore.

# Teen rescued after portion of building collapses

Ahmedabad : A teenager was rescued from under the debris after a portion of a dilapidated house collapsed in Golwad area on Sunday noon following heavy rains.

The back portion of a four-storey building in Amdevadi street in Golwad was weakened over the years, collapsed. Fire officials said that the building was a wooden structure constructed around 40 years ago. After Dev was evacuated, he was sent to hospital as he had suffered minor injuries. "Family had some gold ornaments and other important items in the debris. So, we allowed a woman family member to go inside, accompanied by our staff," Pareek said.

When the family living on the first floor of the building was in a crashing sound, they rushed out, but 13-year-old Dev Rana got stuck under the debris. "When our staff entered the building, the boy was stuck in the rubble and only his face and legs were visible. We removed the debris and brought the boy out," said in-charge chief fire officer B K Pareek. After Dev was evacuated, he was sent to hospital as he had suffered minor injuries. "Family had some gold ornaments and other important items in the debris. So, we allowed a woman family member to go inside, accompanied by our staff," Pareek said.

# Harassed by cops for money, bootleggers attempt suicide

Rajkot: Alleging harassment by bribe-demanding police, two bootleggers in Surendranagar district attempted suicide within 24 hours. The cops though refuted the allegations.

A bootlegger identified as Manish alias Munno Khambhaliya recorded a video on his mobile phone and later consumed phenyl. Khambhaliya named four cops in the video alleging that they had taken over Rs 3 lakh from him in the last six months. He said that now the cops were demanding Rs 25,000 more.

Khambhaliya also accused the four policemen of using the names of superintendent of Surendranagar police and the district collector while demanding money. He further said the cops threatened to frame him in a false case. Khambhaliya is being treated in Surendranagar and cops said that his condition is stable. In a separate incident, another bootlegger Jagdish alias Jago Koli, a resident of Velnatpura, consumed rat poison at his home. He is now undergoing treatment at Rajkot civil hospital. His wife and mother alleged that police used to often visit their home at odd hours demanding money. They said that although Koli had stopped the illicit business, police kept demanding money. Top cops, though, refuted the claims. "The duo's allegations are false. They have levelled allegations against those police officials who had registered cases against them in the past," said deputy superintendent of police Himanshu Doshi. He added that Khambhaliya has been booked three while Koli has been booked two. He was even detained under Prevention of Anti-Social Activities (PASA) Act.

# Cow vigilante run over by truck in Valsad, 10 arrested



SURAT: Ten people were detained on Sunday for allegedly running over a cow vigilante who tried to stop them from allegedly transporting cows in a truck on the national highway-48 near Dungi in Valsad district.

Police said that the 10 detainees from Bhiwandi in Maharashtra and Valsad were nabbed following investigation of the road accident that killed self-styled cow vigilante Hardik Kanara when he was trying to stop a cattle-laden truck on June 19 Kanarsa had blocked the highway to nab the truck driver as he had received information that cows were being sent illegally to Maharashtra. The truck driver, however, ran over Kanarsa killing him on the spot and fled leaving his vehicle behind. Police said that 10 cows and a bull were found from the truck. A police official said that different teams were formed to nab the truck driver and others who were allegedly involved in the illegal trade. During the probe, cops found Asgar alias Maysa Ansari, Javed Sheikh, Khalil Sheikh and Jamil Sheikh from Bhiwandi and Ansar Sheikh, Ali Murad Alisar,

Dharmesh Ahir, Kamlesh Ahir, Jayesh Ahir and Hasan Alisar from Valsad. Cops said that they were involved in the illegal trade of cattle and transporting them to Maharashtra from Valsad. Ansari used to buy the cattle for Rs 5,000 to Rs 6,000 and sell them to Jamil for Rs 7,000 to Rs 8,000. # Siddhpur pounded by 206mm rainfall

Ahmedabad : With monsoon advancing further, North Gujarat has started receiving heavy rains. Three districts in the region including Banaskantha, Patan and Mehsana experienced heavy rains since Sunday night. In Patan district, Siddhpur taluka received 206 mm, Saraswati received 150 mm, Radhanpur taluka recorded 181 mm, Chanasma received 90 mm while Samri received 62 mm rainfall. Rainwater entered houses in low lying areas while some residential colonies also witnessed power failure for couple of hours. Intermittent rains continued throughout the day on Monday as well. Like Palanpur, Amirgadh in Banaskantha also witnessed heavy rainfall. Danta, Deesa, Vadgam talukas also witnessed heavy rains. In Mehsana district, Palanpur received 97mm rainfall. Low lying areas in Palanpur including Vrindavan, Kalishahgar, Becharpura, Anandnagar, civil hospital premises, BSR colony and other adjacent areas got inundated with rainwater.

# Gang rape, suicide: Within 10 days of FIR, chargesheet filed in Vadodara



Ahmedabad : The city police on Monday filed a chargesheet in the alleged gangrape and suicide of a 19-year-old girl in a record time.

Police investigated the case, collected evidence and filed a chargesheet against the accused duo in the court within 10 days. The state government has also agreed to rope in a special public prosecutor for the trial.

"We began investigation swiftly and collected clinching evidence against the accused. The motive behind filing the chargesheet within 10 days is to send a strong message of deterrence. Such crimes will be taken very seriously and all efforts will be made to punish the culprits," said Shamsher Singh, city police commissioner.

In the chargesheet, the cops have included statements of the eye-witnesses recorded under CrP section 164 and voice spectrograph of the girl's boyfriend. Also, the girl's voice recording that she sent to her boyfriend wherein she said that something bad happened to her, has been included in the chargesheet.

Police are waiting Forensic Science Laboratory (FSL) tests of the semen sample to ascertain if both the accused

- Dishant Kahar and Nazem Mirza - had raped the girl. "In the chargesheet, Dishant has been named as a prime accused while Nazem an accomplice in the crime. Nazem also tried to rape the girl but she warded off his attempts," said a police official. "We talked with the state government on Monday and it agreed to hire a special public prosecutor for a speedy trial," Singh added.

The girl, who worked in a private firm, was raped at her residence in Laximpura area by her colleagues on June 8. Her boyfriend informed her father who then called the accused to his home the next day. Police said that he made them delete all the photographs they had of her along with the chats.

The girl, though committed suicide on June 10 following which the police was informed. The cops then filed an FIR against Dishant and Nazem and arrested them immediately.
