Section 108 and 109 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 and 21(2) of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 as amended time to time to scrutinize the remote e-voting process in respect of the below mentioned resolutions proposed at the 26th AGM of the Shareholders of the Company, held on Wednesday, November 04, 2020 at 11:00 am through Video Conferencing (VC) / Other Audio Visual Means (OAVM) without the physical presence of the Members (also referred as "Shareholders") at a common venue. The notice dated 6th October, 2020 convening the Annual General Meeting of the Company was sent to the shareholders.

In view of the massive outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic, the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA") circular dated May 05, 2020 read with circulars dated April 08, 2020 and April 13, 2020 (collectively referred to as "MCA Circulars") and Securities and Exchange Board of India ("SEBI") circular dated May 12, 2020 ("SEBI Circular") permitted the holding of the AGM through VC / OAVM, without the physical presence of the Members. Further in compliance with the aforesaid MCA Circulars and SEBI Circular, notice of the AGM along with the Annual Report for FY 2019-20 was sent only through electronic mode to those Members whose name appeared in the Register of Members/ Beneficial Owners maintained by the Depositories as on benpos date i.e. 2nd October, 2020, and whose email addresses are registered with the Company/ Depositories. The Notice and Annual Report for FY 2019-20 was also made available on website of the Company, i.e. www.adinatheximresources.com.



Since the AGM was held pursuant to MCA circulars through VC / OAVM, physical attendance of members were dispensed with. Accordingly, in terms of above mentioned MCA and SEBI circulars, the facility for appointment of proxies by members were dispensed with.

Members attended the meeting through VC / OAVM had been counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act'2013 ("the Act").

The compliance of the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules made thereunder relating to voting through electronic means (by remote evoting before and during AGM) by the shareholders on the resolutions proposed to be passed at the 26th Annual General Meeting of the Company is the responsibility of the Management of the Company. Our responsibility as a scrutinizer is to ensure that the voting process both through electronic means before and during meeting are conducted in a fair and transparent manner and to provide a consolidated Scrutinizer's Report of the votes cast "In favour" or "Against" the resolutions to the Chairman or any Director of the Company authorised by the chairman, based on the reports generated from the remote e-voting system of Central Depository Services Limited (CDSL).

I hereby submit my report as under:

1. The Company had provided the remote e-voting facility through Central Depository Services Limited (CDSL) to its Members holding shares of the company as on the cut-off date i.e. Monday, October 28, 2020 to exercise their right to vote by electronic means on any or all of the businesses specified in the Notice of 26th AGM.
